

Are pool safe during this pandemic? YES!

I have spoken to several customers regarding my plans for dealing with the current pandemic. Let me reassure you, I will be able to care for your pool and it is more important than ever that your pool is properly maintained. Pool care workers are considered essential. I can still provide services or repairs at this time. We do not have to see each other nor do we need to be close together. Everything can be done without us having any contact with you. You can leave a check somewhere or pay bills online. We can communicate via text message. No contact necessary.

It is very important you maintain proper levels in your pool. Whether you do it yourself, or have me do it. We are in this together, and I want to make sure your pool is safe - NO MATTER WHO MAINTAINS IT. I have the same test kits that Leslie's uses so I don't mind coming by to check your levels and tell you where you stand with chemicals. If you need me to deliver chemicals, I can bring them and leave them near your pool. You do not need to be a weekly customer - I want your pool safe regardless. Please text me if you need anything at all.
